

Project Overview

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) project to widen a portion of State Route 58 from a two-lane conventional highway to a four-lane expressway, is now in the construction phase. The improvements to State Route 58 extend from approximately 2.8 miles west of Hidden River Road to approximately 0.7 miles east of Lenwood Road, near the unincorporated Community of Hinkley, in San Bernardino County. The expressway would include: 12-foot standard traveled way lanes; 10-foot standard shoulder widths; and a 78-foot-wide median.

Two interchanges will be constructed; one at Hinkley Road and the other at Lenwood Road. This realigned roadway would be constructed on a fill section (elevated sections of a roadway).

Project Construction Schedule*

- Start Concrete Paving New Hwy 58 - April 2016
- New Batch Plant - April 2016
- Complete import of fill - April 2016
- Open Hinkley Road - May 2016
- Open Lenwood Road - February 2016
- Open New Hwy 58 Expressway - November 2016
- Permanent Closure of Existing Hwy 58 to Through Traffic (West of Valley View Rd) - November 2016
- Start Asphalt Overlay on Existing Hwy 58 - November 2016
- Finish Asphalt Overlay on Existing Hwy 58 - December 2016
- Open Lenwood WB Exit Ramp - February 2017
- Planned Construction Duration - Early 2017
